We started the week with the Letter "Cc" and have had fun with clocks, Corduroy, Clifford, and Curious George books. We made a special Crayon Book and listened to the Crayon Box song, trying to keep up with all of the colors.

The rest of the month we will be introduced to the two sounds the letter "Ii" makes. (The short /i/ sound like in itch and inches, and the long /i/ sound, like ice.)

In math we will be counting to 60, as we've been at school 60 days now! We know that that is six groups of tens and zero ones. We will be taking our time to correctly write the numerals 0-10 on lined paper. Ask your child to tell you about AB and ABB patterns.

At 10:00 we will start our way down to the gymnasium for a musical program with Patriotic songs the children have been practicing the last month to honor the Veterans who serve or have served our country.

I hope you've enjoyed listening to your child read the paper books he/she brings home. The students are so proud of themselves and are doing a great job.
